Legal Notice Notice of Application for a Multi-Quarry Permit for Hill County T.P. Construction, Inc., has filed an application with the Department of Environmental Quality for a multi-quarry operating permit under the Metal Mine Reclamation Act. The operating permit would authorize the quarrying of igneous rock (shonkinite and volcanic rock) at two locations. The Beaver Creek quarry site is located about six miles south of Havre, MT in Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 16 East with a plant site located in Section 1, Township 31 North, Range 15 East in Hill County. The Waid Quarry is located about 8 miles southeast of Havre, MT in Sections 2 and 3, Township 31 North, Range 16 East in Hill County. T.P. Construction currently quarries rock at the two sites and needs an operating permit due to proposed expansions of the sites. T.P. Construction proposes to disturb approximately 20 acres at the Beaver quarry and plant site and approximately 17 acres at the Waid Quarry. The crushed rock, about 50,000 cubic yards in total per year, would be used for riprap, railroad ballast, and other purposes. The sites are on private land and would employ up to 18 people.
