NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS

Project Specifications:
1. Inspect and service furnaces and domestic water heaters (DWH) throughout Hill, Blaine, and Liberty counties as well as the Rocky Boy and Ft. Belknap reservations for District 4 Human Resources Development Council's (a.k.a. "HRDC") Energy Assistance Programs.
a. Test all combustion appliances for CO levels, draft, and efficiency.
i. Must document readings using HRDC provided analyzer w/ printer.
ii. Training will be provided.
b. Clean and tune furnaces and water heaters to include, but not limited to:
i. Blower motor cleaning.
ii. Gas valve replacement.
iii. Drip leg installation.
iv. Flue modification to ensure proper clearances.
v. Construct furnace filter rack as needed.
c. Ductwork
i. Installation of new ductwork.
ii. Repair and/or replacement of existing ductwork.

2. Furnace standards:
a. 95% efficiency or higher.
b. 80,000btu (but sizes will vary from project-to-project)
c. Styles will include up-flow and down-flow.
d. Natural gas, propane, and electric.
3. DWH Standards:
a. 40 gallon.
b. 6 year warranty or longer.
c. Site built and mobile home approved units.
d. Atmospheric draft and assisted draft (aka "power vent").
e. Natural gas, propane, and electric.

Proposals must include:
1. Product manuals, warranty details, and service guarantees.
2. Mileage rate for jobs 30 miles from HRDC.
3. Business licenses and contractor certificates (current and in good standing).
4. Proof of insurance: general liability and workers compensation.
5. DUNS number and SAM.gov registration.
6. EPA Renovation, Repair, and Paint Rule (RRP) certification.
7. OSHA 10 for employees. OSHA 30 for crew leaders.

Proposals must demonstrate:
1. Capacity to provide emergency furnace repairs and replacements by having available staff and equipment in stock.
a. Must respond to life-threatening emergencies within 18 hours.
b. Must respond to all other emergencies within 48 hours.

PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY TO PROTEST TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF MONTANA ALL-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

Andy's, LLC (Shaina Hofeldt, Owner) has applied to transfer Montana All-Alcoholic Beverages License No. 12-501-3446-001 to be operated at Andy's Supper Club, 658 1st Street West, Havre, Hill County, Montana. The public may protest this license transfer in accordance with the law.

Who can protest this transfer? Protests will be accepted from residents of the county of the proposed location (Hill), residents of adjoining Montana counties (Liberty, Chouteau, Blaine), and residents of adjoining counties in another state if the criteria in 16-4-207(4)(d), Montana Code Annotated (MCA), are met.

What information must be included? Protest letters must be legible and contain (1) the protestor's full name, mailing address, and street address; (2) the license number (12-501-3446-001) and the applicant's name (Andy's, LLC) (3) an indication that the letter is intended as a protest; (4) a description of the grounds for protesting; and (5) the protestor's signature. A letter with multiple signatures will be considered one protest letter.

What are valid protest grounds? The protest may be based on the applicant's qualifications listed in 16-4-401, MCA, or the grounds for denial of an application in 16-4-405, MCA. Examples of valid protest grounds include: (1) the applicant is unlikely to operate the establishment in compliance with the law; (2) the proposed location cannot be properly policed by local authorities; and (3) the welfare of the people in the vicinity of the proposed location will be adversely and seriously

affected.
How are protests submitted? Protests must be postmarked to the Department of Revenue, Office of Dispute Resolution, P.O. Box 5805, Helena, Montana 59604-5805 on or before September 4, 2018.

What happens if the transfer is protested? Depending on the number of protests and the protest grounds, a public hearing will be held in Helena or Havre. All valid protestors will be notified of the hearing's time, date and location. Hearings typically are scheduled within 90 days. A protestor's hearing testimony is limited to the grounds in the protestor's letter. Following the hearing, the Department of Revenue will notify the public whether the license transfer is approved or denied.
