YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a Petition for Termination of Parental Rights and Permanent Legal Custody ("the Petition") regarding, D.H., the child who is the subject of the above-captioned proceedings brought pursuant to Title 41, Chapter 3 of the Montana Code Annotated, has been filed in Cause No. DN-17-032 in Montana Twelfth Judicial District Court, in Hill County by the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services, Child and Family Services (CFS), located at 232 1st Street West, Suite B, Havre, MT, 59501.

The Petition requests that CFS be granted the following relief: Termination of Parental Rights and Permanent Legal Custody. A copy of the Petition is filed with the Clerk of District Court for Hill County, Montana, (406) 400-2414, and is hereby served upon you at this time.

The child who is the subject of the proceedings, D.H., was born on April 8, 2017 in Havre, Montana. The child's mother is Leena Galen Healy and there are no other names she has used. The child's father is any and all unknown or putative fathers.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to appear at the hearing regarding the Petition that is set on the **23rd day of May, 2019, at 3:00 o'clock p.m.**, at the Hill County Courthouse, Montana, located at 315 4th Street, Havre, Montana, and there to show cause, if any you may have, why CFS should not be granted the relief requested in the Petition.

NOTICE: Your failure to appear at the hearing will constitute a denial of interest in the child, which denial may result, without further notice of this proceeding or any subsequent proceeding, in judgment by default being entered for the relief requested in the Petition.

You have the right to be represented by an attorney in these proceedings. If you are unable to afford an attorney, the Court will have an attorney appointed to represent you.

PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY TO PROTEST TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF MONTANA ALL-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

Fresno Tavern, LLC (Kodi Peterson, Owner) has applied to transfer Montana All-Alcoholic Beverages License No. 12-999-3358-001 to be operated at Fresno Tavern, 37980 US Highway 2, Havre, Hill County. The public may protest this license transfer in accordance with the law.

Who can protest this transfer? Protests will be accepted from residents of the county of the proposed location (Hill), residents of adjoining Montana counties (Choteau, Liberty and Blaine), and residents of adjoining counties in another state if the criteria in 16-4-207(4)(d),

Montana Code Annotated (MCA), are met.

What information must be included? Protest letters must be legible and contain (1) the protestor's full name, mailing address, and street address; (2) the license number (12-999-3358-001) and the applicant's name (Fresno Tavern, LLC); (3) an indication that the letter is intended as a protest; (4) a description of the grounds for protesting; and (5) the protestor's signature. A letter with multiple signatures will be considered one protest letter.

What are valid protest grounds? The protest may be based on the applicant's qualifications listed in 16-4-401, MCA, or the grounds for denial of an application in 16-4-405, MCA. Examples of valid protest grounds include: (1) the applicant is unlikely to operate the establishment in compliance with the law; (2) the proposed location cannot be properly policed by local authorities; and (3) the welfare of the people in the vicinity of the proposed location will be adversely and seriously affected.

How are protests submitted? Protests must be postmarked to the Department of Revenue, Office of Dispute Resolution, P.O. Box 5805, Helena, Montana, 59604-5805 on or before April 18, 2019.

What happens if the transfer is protested? Depending on the number of protests and the protest grounds, a public hearing will be held in Helena or Havre. All valid protestors will be notified of the hearing's time, date and location. Hearings typically are scheduled within 90 days. A protestor's hearing testimony is limited to the grounds in the protestor's letter. Following the hearing, the Department of Revenue will notify the public whether the license transfer is approved or denied.

LEGAL NOTICE

Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks is proposing to re-establish self-sustainable sharp-tailed grouse populations west of the Continental Divide. FWP would achieve this objective through reintroductions of sharp-tailed grouse in core areas with the most suitable habitat: the Blackfoot Valley; the northern Bitterroot Valley; and the Drummond Area. FWP would capture a total of 75-180 grouse each year for five years across Regions 4, 5, 6, and 7. Capture locations would be dispersed in a way that would minimize impact to source populations. The Western Montana Sharp-tailed Grouse Reintroduction draft environmental assessment was released for a 30-day public comment period on Feb. 15. FWP received 52 comments for the draft EA. The public comments were generally positive and supportive in nature with few comments either neutral or non-supportive. The draft EA did not identify any significant negative impacts through the proposed action to Montana's sharp-tailed grouse population. In reviewing all the public comments and other relevant information, and evaluating the environmental effects, we recommend that the Fish and Wildlife Commission approve Alternative B, Reintroduction of Sharp-tailed Grouse in the Blackfoot Valley, the Northern Bitterroot Valley, and the Drummond Area. FWP believes the completion of this alternative provides the best opportunity for returning self-sustaining, viable populations of STGR to

western Montana. Based on the draft EA, which has not identified any significant negative impacts by the proposed action to Montana's STGR population, an EIS is not required, an EA is the appropriate level of review. Noting and including the responses to public comments, the draft EA will become the final EA and together with this decision notice will serve as the final documents for this proposal.

The Fish and Wildlife Commission is scheduled to review the proposal at its April 25 meeting in Bozeman.
