- A. One year contract to provide District 4 HRDC labor and materials for weatherization projects. B. Contractor must be will to serve families with low income within Blaine, Hill, and Liberty counties; which includes Rocky Boy, and Ft. Belknap Reservations. C. Contractor is responsible for completing all projects in strict compliance with the Standard Work Specifications (SWS) for Single-Family homes created by Montana DPHHS. D. Contractor must be willing to work under mobile homes, oftentimes in sub-zero temperatures. E. Contractor must handle exposure to hazards such as Lead, Mold, Asbestos, Unruly Clients, Aggressive Animals, and Illegal Substance Abuse, in a professional manner. F. Pipe Wrapping of water lines and Earthquake Strapping water heaters. 6. Installation of vents (Roof, Gable, and Foundation). 7. Any other energy related measure or minor repair stated in Work Order.
