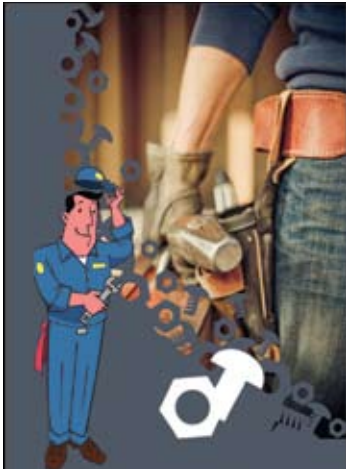

NOTICE INVITING CONTRACTOR PROPOSALS FOR INSTALLATION OF INSULATION AND ENERGY RELATED REPAIR WORK

- I. Project Specifications:**
- One year contract to provide District 4 HRDC labor and materials for weatherization projects.
 - Contractor must be will to serve families with low income within Blaine, Hill, and Liberty counties; which includes Rocky Boy, and Ft. Belknap Reservations.
 - Contractor is responsible for completing all projects in strict compliance with the Standard Work Specifications (SWS) for Single-Family homes created by Montana DPHHS.
 - Contractor must be willing to work under mobile homes, oftentimes in sub-zero temperatures.

Legals

- Contractor must handle exposure to hazards such as Lead, Mold, Asbestos, Unruly Clients, Aggressive Animals, and Illegal Substance Abuse, in a professional manner.
- Contractor must possess all tools necessary to complete all projects.
- District 4 HRDC does have an insulation trailer the contractor may rent, if needed. The insulation trailer consists of an insulation machine, generator to operate, and required hoses.
- Work will begin within seven days of receiving receipt of work order and completed within 15 days after starting project.
- All projects will be inspected by Program Director, Director Designee, or Quality Control Inspector before receiving payment.
- Any unsatisfactory work or work not completed per Standard Work Specifications (SWS) will be remedied by Contractor at expense of the Contractor and reinspected before payment.
- Weatherization projects include, but are not limited to:
 - Insulating Attics, Basements, Crawlspace, Rim Joist, and Mobile Home Bellies.
 - Window and Door repair and replacement.
 - Heat Duct cleaning, repair, insulating, and air sealing.
 - Repair, Replacement, and/or New installation of exhaust equipment.
 - Pipe Wrapping of water lines and Earthquake Strapping water heaters.
 - Installation of vents (Roof, Gable, and Foundation).
 - Any other energy related measure or minor repair stated in Work Order.

- Current Proof of Insurance (\$1m per incident, \$2m aggregate).

 - A Lumber yard supplying materials.
 - A glass shop that does Thermal Window Repair.
- ASHRAE Certification or statement expressing a willingness to obtain within one year of contract award date.
- EPA Lead Renovation, Repair, and Paint Certification or a statement expressing a willingness to obtain within one year of contract award date.
- Completed Contractors Application with completed Cost Proposal Sheet.
