REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES

Hill County has been awarded a federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) by the Montana Department of Commerce (DOC) to conduct a Preliminary Architectural Report (PAR) for renovation of the Rudyard Senior Center. With the award of funding, Hill County is soliciting proposals to hire a firm to provide architectural services to prepare a PAR. The PAR must follow the requirements set forth by the CDBG Program. The agreement and payment terms will be negotiated with the selected offeror.

The selected offeror will develop recommendations regarding possible renovations to the existing facility for improved functionality and expanded services. The final report must comply with the requirements of the latest version of the CDBG Preliminary Architectural Report (PAR) outline. Following pre-design approval, the selected consultant may also be asked, at the discretion of Hill County, to assist in developing a final construction design, preparing construction bid documents, facilitating project bidding, and overseeing construction activities.

Disadvantaged and women-owned businesses are encouraged to apply. The selection of finalists to be interviewed will be based on an evaluation of the written responses. The award will be made to the most qualified offeror whose proposal is deemed most advantageous to Hill County, all factors considered. Unsuccessful offerors will be notified as soon as possible. All responses must be received no later than December 1, 2021. Include five copies of the proposals. Proposals may not exceed 20 one-side pages, excluding standard corporate brochures and personnel resumes. Please state "Rudyard Senior Center PAR Proposal" on the outside of the response package.

Work includes architectural site analysis, preparation of cost estimates, and completion of an environmental review checklist.

CDBG regulations governing the grant require that, to the greatest extent feasible, opportunities for training and employment arising in connection with this CDBG-assisted project will be extended to local lower-income residents. Further, to the greatest extent feasible, business concerns located in or substantially owned by residents of the project area will be utilized.
