The Box Elder County Water and Sewer District will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, April 20, 2022. The public hearing will begin at 7:00 p.m. at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Box Elder Montana. The District has scheduled the hearing to obtain public comments regarding the proposed improvements to the Town's wastewater system.
