General Contract for Complete Construction of 7 - 3 Bedroom Homes on Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation, Box Elder, Montana. The Chippewa Cree Housing Authority (hereinafter *the Housing Authority*) will receive one total bid for the Labor and Materials to build 3 homes on the Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation.

SCOPE OF WORK: Homes will be "STICK BUILT" to plans and specifications provided by the Chippewa Cree Housing Authority. Each proposal will include all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals to complete job.

PRE-PROPOSAL CONFERENCE: A Pre-Proposal Conference is scheduled for 07/13/2022 at 10:00 a.m. at the Chippewa Cree Housing Authority Conference Room. All Interested Contractors/individuals are mandated to attend. Non-attendance will result in rejection of bid.

PROPOSALS: Sealed Proposals will be accepted until 10:00 a.m. on 07/26/2022 at the office of the Housing Authority, Rocky Boy, Montana after which time they will be opened, read aloud, and accepted for consideration. Proposals received after this time will not be accepted.

PREPARATION OF PROPOSAL: Each proposal must be submitted on the "Lump Sum Proposal Form" provided at the pre-proposal conference. Each proposal shall be sealed in an envelope labeled "PROPOSAL DOCUMENTS" and bearing the following information:

Special attention is called to the fact that any State, Local, or Tribal wage rates that exceeds the corresponding federal rate is inapplicable and shall not be enforced.

INDIAN PREFERENCE: It has been determined that this project is subject to Section 7(b) of the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act and CCHA Procurement requirements.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PLANNING CONSULTANT SERVICES - DISASTER RECOVERY AND RESILIENCY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Bear Paw Development Corporation has received funding from the Economic Development Administration through the federal CARES Act for preparation of a Disaster Recovery and Resiliency Economic Development Plan and is soliciting proposals for consultant services to assist in preparing the Plan. Payment terms will be negotiated with the selected offeror.

Work activities include utilizing existing disaster recovery and resiliency plans already in place for areas in our five county Economic Development District, in addition to new data, to compile a document that incorporates a focus on pandemic recovery and resilience based on existing or anticipated COVID-19 impacts, general needs, and capacities of the Bear Paw Economic Development District. This document will result in a comprehensive plan for the following counties: Hill, Blaine, Phillips, Chouteau, and Liberty, in addition to the Rocky Boy's and Fort Belknap Indian Reservations. This Recovery and Resiliency Plan will focus heavily on the COVID-19 pandemic, and propose various economic and community recovery strategies. The target completion date for this project is November 30, 2022.

- Responses should include:
1. The firm's legal name, address, and telephone number;
2. The principal(s) of the firm and their experience and qualifications;
3. The experience and qualifications of the staff to be assigned to the project;
4. A description of the firm's prior experience with developing feasibility studies; and
5. The proposed work plan and schedule for activities to be performed.

PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY TO PROTEST TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF MONTANA ALL-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE

AT ST. JOHN, LLC (Anthony St. John, Owner(s)) has applied to transfer Montana All-Alcoholic Beverages License No. 12-501-3415-002 to be operated at RIGATONY'S, 1400 1st St, Havre, Hill

County. The public may protest this license transfer in accordance with the law.

Who can protest this transfer? Protests will be accepted from residents of the county of the proposed location Hill County, residents of adjoining Montana counties, and residents of adjoining counties in another state if the criteria in 16-4-207(4)(d), Montana Code Annotated (MCA), are met.

What information must be included? Protest letters must be legible and contain (1) the protestor's full name, mailing address, and street address; (2) the license number 12-501-3415-002 and the applicant's name AT ST. JOHN, LLC; (3) an indication that the letter is intended as a protest; (4) a description of the grounds for protesting; and (5) the protestor's signature. A letter with multiple signatures will be considered one protest letter.

What are valid protest grounds? The protest may be based on the applicant's qualifications listed in 16-4-401, MCA, or the grounds for denial of an application in 16-4-405, MCA. Examples of valid protest grounds include: (1) the applicant is unlikely to operate the establishment in compliance with the law; (2) the proposed location cannot be properly policed by local authorities; and (3) the welfare of the people in the vicinity of the proposed location will be adversely and seriously affected.

How are protests submitted? Protests must be postmarked to the Department of Revenue, Office of Dispute Resolution, P.O. Box 5805, Helena, Montana 59604-5805 on or before July 11, 2022.

What happens if the transfer is protested? Depending on the number of protests and the protest grounds, a public hearing will be held in Helena or Havre. All valid protesters will be notified of the hearing's time, date and location. Hearings typically are scheduled within 90 days. A protestor's hearing testimony is limited to the grounds in the protestor's letter. Following the hearing, the Department of Revenue will notify the public whether the license transfer is approved or denied.
