The Chippewa Cree Housing Authority (hereinafter \*the Housing Authority\*) will receive one total bid for the Labor and Materials to build 5 homes on the Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation.

**SCOPE OF WORK:** Homes will be "STICK BUILT" to plans and specifications provided by the Chippewa Cree Housing Authority. Each proposal will include all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals to complete job.

**PRE-PROPOSAL CONFERENCE:** A Pre-Proposal Conference is scheduled for 09/21/2022 at 10:00 a.m. at the Chippewa Cree Housing Authority Conference Room. All Interested Contractors/individuals are mandated to attend. Non-attendance will result in rejection of bid.

**PROPOSALS:** Sealed Proposals will be accepted until 10:00 a.m. on 10/05/2022 at the office of the Housing Authority, Rocky Boy, Montana after which time they will be opened, read aloud, and accepted for consideration. Proposals received after this time will not be accepted.
