Request for Qualifications, Rocky Boy Health Center new Youth Wellness facility:

The Rocky Boy Health Center invites the submission of responses to this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) from qualified teams(s) interested in providing architectural, engineering, and general contracting services under an Integrated Project Delivery agreement. The Rocky Boy Health Center (RBHC), located on the Rocky Boy's Reservation, Chippewa Cree Tribe in North-Central Montana, is looking to expand its health services offerings to include facilities specifically for the youth living on the reservation. The project has been named the Miyo Pimatisiwinikamik Youth Center, or Miyo for short. The preliminary program for the Miyo includes a 25,000sf to 30,000sf building with offices, exam rooms, multi-purpose classrooms, commercial kitchen and cafeteria, gymnasium sized for two basketball courts without bleachers, fitness instruction room, and open gathering/ flex space. Outdoor amenities include 2 basketball courts, large courtyard with interactive fountains (part time splash pad), indoor/ outdoor cultural activities, combined soccer/ football field, and small horse corral. The site dedicated to this project sits north of the existing Rocky Boy Health Center facility, just across Upper Box Elder Rd., and encompasses approximately 8 acres. Prior workshops and programming have been completed with the RBHC and the community at large, the results of which are detailed in the full RFQ. Design is to commence in the spring of 2023 with construction to commence no later than spring of 2024. RFQ responses are due by 4:00pm Tuesday, February 28, 2023.
