The IRMP will assess and discuss management of various tribal natural resources on the reservation. It will include data analysis of tribal resources, discussion of tribal departments that manage these resources and their progress, as well as mitigation of resources and the effects of climate change and its effects on our resources on tribal lands on the Rocky Boy's Indian Reservation. The potential contractor will need to hold stakeholder meetings and conduct interviews with the public and the cultural community to gather information pertinent to the plan.
