Total Cost \$3,594,608 The Town of Chester (Town), through

a 2022 Wastewater Improvements Preliminary Engineering Report (PER), analyzed the condition of its wastewater collection and treatment system components. It was determined that the collection system has deteriorated over the years and needs rehabilitation or replacement to reduce infiltration and inflow, and that the four existing lift stations have neared the end of their useful life. In addition, valves and control structures at the lagoon facility are inoper-

able, and accumulated sludge in the lagoon cells has resulted in odors and reduced detention time for treatment. Wastewater treatment improvements include removal of sludge from Cell 1 and replacement of existing valves, control structures, and the flow measuring device at the existing lagoon facility. The sludge from Cell 1 will be dredged from the lagoon, hauled in liquid form, and land applied onto nearby agricultural land.

An environmental assessment (EA) was issued on October 4, 2023. by the Department for the proposed Town of Chester Wastewater Improvements Phase 1 Project. On October 17, 2023, the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the EA was published in The Havre Daily News. A 30-day public comment period followed, and no public comments were received. This Amended FONSI is being issued to address. and publicly notice, an expansion to the potential sludge disposal area for the Chester wastewater project. The EA identified two potential acreages for land application of the biosolids removed from the existing lagoon cells. Since the publication of the FONSI last October, additional potential acreage has been identified. This Amended FONSI also notices installation of a new lagoon liner in Cell 1, added to the project scope through a change order. All other aspects of the Chester wastewater project were adequately covered by the FA and remain unchanged. As indicated in the EA, sludge will be land-applied to farmland in accordance with Federal 40 CFR 503 sludge disposal regulations. The land application of sludge will enhance soil conditions and provide beneficial reuse of the biosolids. Federal and State grant/loan programs will fund the project. Environmentally sensitive characteristics such as wetlands, floodplains, threatened or endangered species, and historical sites are not expected to be proposed project. Public participation


